- ❖ This fee will be applied to your total Troop camp fees, but is non-refundable if you do not attend Camp Shenandoah 2012.
- ❖ 100% of fees must be paid before access to on-line merit badge session sign-ups will be provided.
- ❖ In-council fees: Youth \$225, if paid in full by May 1, 2012 and \$250 after.
- ❖ Out-of Council fees: Youth \$245 if paid in full by May 1, 2012 and \$270 after.
- ❖ Adult leader fee is \$100.
- ❖ Reference the Camp Shenandoah Leader Guide for all other programming fees and forms.
- ❖ You must have a minimum of two (2) adult leaders with your unit at all times. If you are unable to provide the needed leadership, please contact us, we will work with you.
- ❖ Units registering with less than the minimum number of youth and adult leadership for a desired site may be required to share their campsite with another unit.
